- **From North of Binghamton (Syracuse):** take I-81 South to Route 17 West and proceed to Exit 67N. Take McKinley Ave North to east Main Street and turn left on East Main. School is 1200 East Main Street.
- **From West of Binghamton (Rochester/Buffalo):** take I-390 South to I-86/Route 17 East and proceed to Exit 67N. Follow directions above at the exit.
- **From South of Binghamton (LI and NYC):** take NYS Thruway to Route 17 Exit and go west on Route 17 to Exit 67N. Follow directions above at the exit. (alternate is I-81 N thru PA to Route 17 West to Exit 67N)
- **From East of Binghamton (Albany):** Take I-88 to I-81 and go South, follow signs for Route 17 West. Proceed to Exit 67N and follow directions above.

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Tournament open to NY residents only.
- Entry Fee is \$25. There will be NO REFUNDS. Checks payable to Shamrock Wrestling Club.
- General Admission will be \$10 adults / \$5 children 7-14 yrs old
  - Maximum of \$25 for family
- Medical Staff will be on site during the entire tournament.

## REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

- **NO WALK-INS.** All Registration Forms **MUST** be mailed to the address listed below.
- Registration deadline is March 6<sup>th</sup>. All registrations must be received by the deadline. No registrations accepted at weigh-ins.
- No weight allowances. Wrestlers must make the weight listed on the registration form. There will be no moving up in weight – please make sure the proper weight class is entered on the application.

## WEIGH-IN INFORMATION:

- Intermediate & Novice Divisions –
  - Weigh-Ins Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup> from 4:00 – 8:00 PM
  - Wrestling on Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 AM to completion. Both Divisions will finish on Saturday.
- Bantam & Schoolboy Divisions –
  - Weigh-Ins Saturday, March 14<sup>th</sup> from 3:00 – 6:00 PM
  - Wrestling on Sunday, March 15<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 AM to completion.

## TOURNAMENT RULES:

- This is a sanctioned event by USA Wrestling and ALL competitors must have a current USA Wrestling Card. Cards can be purchased on-line at the following link - <https://www.themat.com/membership/>  
All participants should have a copy of their card and a copy of their birth certificate (if the card says “Pending”) with them at registration.
- Only Coaches with current USA Wrestling Cards will be permitted matside, with a MAXIMUM of 2 coaches per corner. No cards will be available on-site. They may be purchased on-line at the same link shown above. Note – coaches are required to pass a Background check this year before the card will be issued.
- Headgear, singlet and wrestling shoes (no sneakers) are mandatory.
- Tournament seeding will be done using the automatic seeding points as shown on application form. Wrestlers from the same team will be separated to the extent possible.
- Awards will be presented to the top six (6) in each weight class.
